Investment Scams

Here's how they work: Investment scammers claim you'll get big returns investing in a hot new money-making "opportunity" — maybe something like cryptocurrency. Some scammers say you'll make a lot of money if you follow their proven system or method. Scammers are convincing and the lure of large returns can be enticing. But use caution and don't feel pressured to commit quickly – here's what you can do to spot this scam:



Too good to be true. Be wary if the returns seem too good to be true or are 'guaranteed'. There are no guaranteed returns and no investments without risks. Be wary if the risks are downplayed or you are told that there is no risk.



Special deal to act fast. Use caution if you are pressured to commit quickly or 'space is limited'. Scammers want you to act fast before you realize it is scam.



Funds sent to individuals or accounts not in your name. Be careful sending funds to individuals or accounts not in your name for an investment. Scammers will often have you send funds to another person instead of to the name of a legitimate investment company.



Do some homework. Search online for the name of the company or the program and words like "review", "scam", "fraud," or "complaint." Other people's experience with the company can alert you to possible problems.



Verify investment claims on your own. Never put money into an investment based only on what someone claims or what you read in an online newsletter, review, or blog. Scammers will often invent stories or testimonials about how successful people are at making money with their investment offer.
